Over 33 Years of Preaching the Gospel



Domestic violence is a pattern of coercive, controlling behavior that can include physical abuse, emotional or psychological abuse, sexual abuse or financial abuse and any other behavior to establish power and control. Domestic violence is pervasive and affects millions of individuals across the United States regardless of age, economic status, race, religion, education gender, sexual orientation, or any other identity.



What to do if you are in an abusive situation.

- Talk to someone you trust, a family member, friends, clergy, nurse or doctor.
- Know where your important papers are in case you must leave in a hurry.
- Keep them in a safe place.
- Plan to go to a safe place. such as a shelter or a family members house.
- Call the police any time you feel in immediate danger.
- The National Domestic Violence Hotline can give you the name of the local shelter.
