Pastor Dr. Quintin P. Woods, Sr.



Pastor Quintin P. Woods, Sr. was born in Birmingham, Alabama on October 14, 1971. Pastor Woods is the youngest of thirteen children of Pastor Dr. Calvin W. Woods, Sr., Pastor of Shiloh Baptist Church in Birmingham, Alabama and the late Sister Lucille Woods. This fourth generational licensed and ordained pastor and preacher has been preaching for thirty-four years and pastoring for almost thirty-one years. He has also been married to Mrs. Tramella Woods for almost twenty-seven years, and they are the proud parents of one daughter, Quinteria Tramece Woods, and one son, Quintin Prescott Woods, Jr.

Pastor Woods attended A. H. Parker High School in Birmingham, Alabama where he graduated with the 11th highest GPA in a Senior Class of almost 300 seniors. He was Vice President of his Senior Class and Captain of the Varsity Football Team in which he was a starter for all four years. He also represented the entire student body in helping to select a new principal for the high school, his senior year. He is a graduate of the University of North Alabama where he earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Marketing. While attending the University of North Alabama, Pastor Woods was the captain of the 1993 University of North Alabama Football Team where they were Division II National Champions. He was voted #1 by the coaching staff as the most reliable player on the entire team that could be counted on the most. He was the fastest and strongest pound for pound player on the team. He was invited to the NFL and CFL combine. Instead of pursuing his NFL dreams, he submitted to the Lord's Will to run touchdowns for Him in full time ministry. While in college at the University Of North Alabama, he was active in Athletes For Christ, a Bible Teacher, active in the Student Fellowship, and a Dorm Counselor.

He has also earned a Bachelor of Theology Degree from the Birmingham Easonian Baptist Bible College where he was an honor student. He has also earned a Master of Theology Degree from Rushing Springs School of Theology and a Master of Divinity Degree from Christian Bible College and Seminary. In 2003, he earned a Doctor of Divinity Degree from Christian Bible College and Seminary. He is also certified to teach and facilitate on the local, state, and national level having completed the COPP Program in 2006. He is certified to teach two courses in the COPP and Congress of Christian Education on the Local, State, and National level. In the Spring of 2017, he received an Honorary Doctor of Divinity Degree from St. Thomas Christian University.

Also, while a student-athlete at the University Of North Alabama, he was called to pastor the East Florence Missionary Baptist Church in Florence, Alabama. After serving and worshipping God at East Florence Missionary Baptist Church, Pastor Woods was pastor and organizer of Mount Canaan Baptist Church in Sheffield, Alabama. After graduating from the University of North Alabama, he resigned as pastor of Mount Canaan Baptist Church and returned home to Shiloh Baptist Church in Birmingham, Alabama where he served as an Associate Minister under his father. In February of 1996, Pastor Quintin P. Woods, Sr. embarked upon as Pastor of the Mount Calvary Missionary Baptist Church in Anniston, Alabama in which he faithfully served right at almost nineteen years.

A tremendous amount of growth, development, expansion, and mortgage burning took place under his pastorate and administration at Mount Calvary. He is a called, chosen, and commissioned *Born Again* Servant of God. Truly, souls were saved, lives were transformed and positively impacted, spirits were lifted, and many were blessed and helped under the Pastoral Leadership of Pastor Quintin P. Pastor Woods is an experienced pastor, preacher, and teacher, ministering through the Word of God on the local, state, and national level. He is a gifted Pastor, preacher, Bible and Seminary Teacher, leader, Evangelist, Dedicated Servant, and Man of God. Also, he has served as a Second Vice Moderator for five years. He has served as a Vice Moderator for ten years. He also served as a Moderator for almost two years before moving to Florida. He has served as a Board Member of Habitat for Humanity and on the Committee for Church Relations for Habitat for Humanity for several years. He also served as an Executive Board Member for the Boys and Girls Club of East Central Alabama for over twelve years. He served as an Advisory Board Member for Calhoun Christian Women's Job Corps for over eleven years. Also, he has been a member of the Prayer Intercessory Ministry which his father organized.

He served as an Instructor at the Birmingham Easonian Baptist Bible College Extension School in Anniston, Alabama for over fourteen years. He has taught ten different courses. He has been a Certified Instructor, Lecturer, Facilitator, and Cluster Leader for over twenty-seven years.

He has been a member of the National Baptist Convention, USA, Inc. for almost thirty-one years. He is an active member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. Before moving to Florida, he was a part of Anniston-Piedmont Alumni Chapter (Yo Nupe), in which he was the Director and an Advisor for the Chapter's Guide Right Program – Kappa League, the Fraternities' National Youth Initiative Program which focuses on molding, mentoring, and maturing young males for leadership. He is an active member of the Cocoa Merritt-Island Alumni Chapter.

He has also served as a volunteer for many years in different school systems. He has also served as a motivational and commencement speaker from the Pre-K to the University/Collegiate/Seminary Level. He was a member of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC)-Anniston Chapter, in which he has served as chaplain. Then too, for several years he coached little league football, basketball, and track and field.

He was also chosen as Who's Who Among Christian Leaders by the Heritage Registry which was published in Washington D.C. in the Library of Congress and in other publications. He has also received several other achievements and awards which are too numerous to list. Then too, he has been recognized, interviewed, and profiled by several organizations for his outstanding leadership ability. He is a songwriter and an aspiring author. In addition to all these blessings, his greatest blessing is that this called, chosen, and commissioned servant of God has been Born-Again. Pastor Woods believes that the mission and mandate of the church is to *call* people to Christ, to *build* people up in Christ, and *send* people out for Christ.

Since his tenure and under his leadership, his God given vision for the church is becoming a reality as the church has and is experiencing growth in all areas and aspects.

Also, in 2016 Pastor Woods was appointed to the following Leadership Positions: Vice Chairman Of The Voting Election Commission Committee of the Florida General Baptist State Convention to elect the new State President in 2018 and 2023, 2nd Vice Moderator, Advisor To The Moderator, and Assistant Bible Expositor of Mt. Zion Northeast Coast Missionary Baptist District Association. He also served as Chairman Of The Voting Commission of The District in 2016 to elect the Moderator of the District Association. Also, in 2018 he was appointed by the State President of Florida General Baptist Convention to serve as the

Executive Secretary to The President for five years. He also served on the Credential Committee for the State Convention and Financial Oversight Committee. In 2019 he was appointed as the Bible Expositor for the South End Union and Mt. Zion Northeast Coast Missionary Baptist District Association. In 2020, he was appointed to serve as President of the South End Union.

He also presently serves in the following positions: Member of the Push Back Coalition, Member and Vice President of Brevard Justice Ministry, now BRIGHT – Brevard Righteously Igniting Good Hope Today, President of the Mount Zion District Association Congress of Christian Education, Certified Instructor, and Advisor to the Moderator of the District. On the State and National level, he serves as a Board Member for Florida General Baptist Convention, Certified Instructor for Florida General Baptist Congress and the National Baptist Congress, and Finance Director of Florida General Baptist Convention.
